


Hi everyone,

Happy December! With this comes the end of 2020, and what a year. I'm sure it's one we will never forget. Just imagine the stories that will be told to our children's children and beyond. :0)

If you're a rider that wants to get out at least one time every month, December brings with it Snow, Ice and the dreaded SALT. SALT is great for melting the ice and snow but not too friendly to your bike. If you take the bike out, and there was salt put down, even if it has dried, the dust is as corrosive

as the liquid form. Be sure to take the time to properly wash the bike and dry it; one of those air dryer's works great for blowing off the bike and they are not overly expensive.
