Q: Why do road motorcycles have neutral between 1st and 2nd gear?

A: Logically, the shift pattern would start with Neutral on the bottom and then go up from there: 1,2,3, and so on.

The really GOOD NEWS is that someone way back when, realized the danger in that pattern and moved Neutral up so that it's between 1st and 2nd.

Why?

Here's the scenario. You're running at slightly fast speeds on this curvy road, shifting up and down as needed. But you aren't paying particular attention to the gear you're in other than "is it the correct gear for your speed?"

At the end of this long straightaway while preparing for a tight corner, you begin slowing by braking and shifting down gear after gear. As you reach the corner and do your last downshift you find that instead of shifting into 1st in order to maximize your acceleration and control through and out of the corner, that you were already in 1st and instead of shifted into neutral. Which means you're suddenly freewheeling and not slowing and the engine power you were counting on to help control your drive through and exit from the corner ISN'T there.






All proceeds go to buy more animals for the kids of DCFS. We will have both a live auction and a silent auction. All items will be awarded that day.
